Artworks must be stable and well-constructed, must be creative and original, and must not pose a safety hazard to the public.	
Gatakers Artspace retains a 25% commission on sales.	
Artists are responsible for transport or post of items and associated costs to and from Gatakers Artspace.	
Artists are responsible insurance of items while in transit.	
Gatakers Artspace provides Insurance coverage for artworks while on display in the shop.	
Artworks will be kept on display for a maximum of six months. After this time, the artworks will be reviewed by the Artspace Staff and may be returned to the artist. Artists will be notified via letter or telephone call if their artworks are to be removed from sale. Artists are responsible for collecting their own artworks within 14 days of notification. Artworks not collected within the agreed period of time will become the property of Fraser Coast Regional Council and may therefore be disposed of under HBCC (Administration) Local Law No. 1 (Part 5 – Miscellaneous, 20. Unclaimed Goods).	
The artist is to provide the following information for each artwork supplied: Title or description; medium; insurance price; retail price including Artspace commission and, if applicable, GST.	
Payment for works sold will be made on a monthly basis to the artist via EFT from the Fraser Coast Regional Council. Artists will be advised of sales and will need to invoice Fraser Coast regional Council.
